	<b>216.2. SUPPLEMENTAL DISCIPLINE RECORDS</b>	
<p>1. Authority</p> <p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>The Career and Technology Center shall maintain required records obtained from the districts concerning adjudicated students and transfer students disciplined for offenses involving weapons, alcohol, drugs and violence on school property.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Adjudicated Students</u></b></p> <p>Through the juvenile probation department, the court shall report to school principals information concerning the adjudication of an enrolled student. Such reports shall include a description of delinquent acts committed by the student, disposition of the case, probation or treatment reports, prior delinquent history, the supervision plan, and any other information deemed necessary. Records of students enrolled in the Career and Technology Center shall be provided to the CTC principal by the districts.</p> <p>The CTC principal must share this information with the student’s teacher or principal of another school to which the student may transfer.</p> <p>Required reports concerning an adjudicated student shall be maintained separately from the student’s official school record.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Transfer Students</u></b></p> <p>Upon registration and prior to admission to the school district, the parent, guardian, or person having charge of the student shall provide a sworn statement or affirmation stating whether the student previously was or presently is suspended or expelled from any public or private school for an offense involving weapons, alcohol or drugs; willful infliction of injury to another person; or any act or violence committed on school property. The statement shall include the dates of suspension or expulsion and the name of the school from which the student was suspended or expelled for these reasons. District principals will provide these records to the CTC principal for all students enrolled in the CTC.</p> <p>Parents and guardians shall be informed that any willful false statements concerning this registration shall be a misdemeanor of the third degree.</p> <p>This registration statement shall be maintained as part of the student’s disciplinary record.</p>	<p>Title 42                  Sec. 6341                  SC 1304-A</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SC 1304-A</p>

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	<p>When a student transfers to the Career and Technology Center, a certified copy of the student’s disciplinary record shall be obtained from the school from which the student is transferring. This record shall be maintained as part of the student’s disciplinary record and shall be available for inspection as required by law.
