<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Definition</p> <p>3. Authority</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes that the abuse of controlled substances is a serious problem with legal, physical and social implications for the whole school community. As an educational institution, the Career and Technology Center shall strive to prevent abuse of controlled substances.</p> <p>For purposes of this policy, controlled substances shall mean all:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Controlled substances prohibited by federal and state law. 2. Look-alike drugs. 3. Alcoholic beverages. 4. Anabolic steroids. 5. Drug paraphernalia. 6. Any volatile solvents or inhalants, such as but not limited to glue and aerosol products. 7. Prescription or patent drugs, except those for which permission for use in school has been granted pursuant to Joint Operating Committee policy. <p>For purposes of this policy, under the influence shall include any consumption or ingestion of controlled substances by a student.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee prohibits students from using, possessing, distributing, and being under the influence of any controlled substances during school hours, at any time while on school property, at any school-sponsored activity, and during the time spent traveling to and from school and school-sponsored activities.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee may require participation in drug counseling, rehabilitation, testing or other programs as a condition of reinstatement into the Career and Technology Center’s educational or extracurricular programs resulting from violations of this policy.</p>	<p>35 P.S. 780-101 et seq. 42 P.S. 8337 20 U.S.C.
