	<b>225. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY</b>	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee believes that the school should help students to learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee charges each student in the school with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use. An invoice will be issued to each student losing any property belonging to the school or returning it in poor condition.</p> <p>Any invoice not paid prior to graduation is submitted to a constable for collection. Students and/or parents/guardians are therefore responsible for the cost of lost or damaged property or unpaid bills as well as legal expenses and any appropriate fines.</p> <p>Students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for student actions.</p>	<p>SC 103, 777, 801, 1338</p>
