	<b>233. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS</b>	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority</p>	<p>It shall be the policy of the Joint Operating Committee to acknowledge each student's successful completion of the instructional program appropriate to the student's interests and needs by the award of a certificate at fitting ceremonies.</p> <p>The Lebanon County Career and Technology Center will certify to the participating districts the students that are eligible for graduation. Requirements for high school graduation as established in the regulations of the State Board of Education and local sending districts will be adhered to.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall identify the planned courses for which credit toward graduation shall be awarded. These written plans shall be on file in the school and shall be made available upon request for review by the designated representatives of the Department of Education.</p> <p>Students who fail their program will be counseled concerning other placement either at the Lebanon County Career and Technology Center or their home high school.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Refer to Staff Handbook for Graduation Requirements</i></b></p>
