<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority</p>	<p>Administrators set an example in dress and grooming for staff and students to follow. An administrator should present an image of dignity and encourage respect for authority.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming guidelines for administrators in accordance with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be physically clean, neat and well groomed. • Dress in a manner reflecting professional assignment and/or CTC uniform recommendations. • Dress in a fashion that is commonly accepted in this community. • Dress in a manner that does not cause damage to school property. <p>If an administrator feels that an exception to this policy would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the Administrative Director.</p>	<p>SC 510</p>
