State FFA Officers Visited the CTC



Carpentry Class Field Trips

Students from the morning Carpentry class visited Carmany Apartments job site on April 8, 2025. Greg Bishop, General Superintendent, along with his Site Manager Joe Difava, Site Superintendent of Funk Construction led the students through three different buildings, each in a different state of construction. The students saw varying stages of construction including framing, mechanical installation, and siding. They also saw a drywall installer using stilts. The morning ended with all the students getting some swag from Mr. Bishop.

This is a 48-unit apartment complex. The buildings are framed and dried into the weather. There is siding going on the outside. On the inside there are apartments in many different stages of construction. Some units are drywalled and ready for interior doors and trim. There will be all the mechanicals to see being installed: HVAC, fire sprinkler, electric, plumbing, insulation and some minor framing.
