The student must be enrolled in one of the following four course clusters:

1. Construction occupations
2. Manufacturing occupations
3. Technical Service occupations
4. Transportation occupations

Please inform all applicants that payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution upon entry into the second semester, and after presenting grades of the first completed semester.

Applicants must complete the attached form and return to Mr. Large *no later than April 16, 2003* for consideration by a Career and Technology Selection Committee.

After five (5) candidates have been chosen, each one is to submit an essay to *Walter H. Weber Sons, Inc.* in response to any one of the following subjects:

1. Outline your future goals and how this scholarship will help you attain them.
2. Why do you want to be a recipient of this scholarship?
3. What does America mean to you? What future does America hold for you? **NOTE:** The length of the response is not important.

The final decision will be made by a Selection Committee from *Walter H. Weber Sons, Inc.* and will be based on the merits of a personal interview, the essay and the application.

Scholarships will be awarded regardless of applicant's race, color, creed, religion, sex, sexual orientation, ancestry, national origin, handicap or disability.

CRITERIA:

1. Graduating student from a *Lebanon County Career & Technology Center* program.
2. Entering a trade school or any other institution of higher learning for the purpose of obtaining a degree of a vocational-technical nature in the construction, manufacturing, technical service or transportation curriculum.
3. The individual must be considered a full-time student by the institution to qualify for the Scholarship and must be accepted by the institution two (2) weeks prior to Awards Night. Proof of acceptance is required for awarding the Scholarship.
4. Transcripts of the grades must be submitted to *Walter H. Weaber Sons, Inc.* as soon as possible after the first semester is completed.
5. A grade average of “C” or better must be attained during the first semester.
6. Payment of the Scholarship will be made directly to the institution upon entry into the second semester.
