	<b>127.1 ASSESSMENTS</b>	
1. Purpose	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes its responsibility to develop and implement an assessment plan that will determine the degree to which students are achieving academic standards and will provide information for improving the educational program.</p>	<p>Title 22 Sec. 4.52</p>
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall approve an assessment plan for use in the CTC that is aligned with the adopted academic standards and state assessments. The assessment plan shall be described in the CTC's Strategic Plan.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee reserves the right to review CTC assessment measures and to approve those that serve a legitimate purpose without infringing upon the personal rights of the students or parents.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall grant requests by parents or guardians to review the state assessments two (2) weeks prior to their administration, during regular office hours. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall recommend methods of assessment and evaluation based on his/her professional judgment, generally accepted professional practice, and staff input.</p> <p><b>The Administrative Director or designee shall annually disseminate to parents and to the public information regarding student assessment results, as required by federal and state law and regulations.</b></p> <p>The Administrative Director shall recommend improvements in the curriculum and instructional practices based upon student assessment results.</p>	<p>Pol. 919</p>
