<b>227. PREGNANT STUDENTS</b>		
1. Purpose	<p>No student, whether married or unmarried, who is otherwise eligible to attend the school shall be denied an educational program solely because of pregnancy, childbirth, pregnancy related disabilities, or actual or potential parenthood; nor shall a pregnant student under the age of 17 be excused from the requirements of the Compulsory Attendance Statute solely for reasons of her pregnancy or maternity.</p>	22 § 12.1 1326
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee reserves the right to require as a prerequisite for attendance in the regular classes of the school that each pregnant student present to the Assistant Principal her physician's written statement that such activity will not be injurious to her health nor jeopardize her pregnancy.</p>	
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Assistant Principal shall implement this policy and also arrange additional counseling services to help the student plan her future wisely.</p>
