	230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority</p> <p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.</p> <p>All requests for public performances or participation by student groups require the approval of the Assistant Principal and Assistant Director.</p> <p>The Assistant Principal shall implement the following procedures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parental permission is sought and received before students may participate. 2. No student is compelled to participate in a public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so. 3. When public performances are scheduled as a regular part of a course of study taken for credit, students shall be informed in advance of their obligation to participate; and they will be excused from participation only in accordance with the rules and procedures governing school attendance. 4. No student, group of students or employees may receive compensation for the performance. 5. All students who are members of the group invited to perform, must be polled to determine their willingness to do so and that no request for a performance be granted unless the faculty advisor believes that a sufficient number will participate to represent the school fairly and to acquire a valuable learning experience. 6. The interests of students are protected and guarded against exploitation.
