	<b>237. ELECTRONIC DEVICES</b>	
<p>1. Authority</p> <p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee prohibits possession of laser pointers and attachments, cellular telephones and telephone paging devices, also refereed to as beepers, by students on school grounds, on buses and other vehicles provided by the CTC, and at CTC sponsored activities.</p> <p>This prohibition shall not apply in the following cases, provided that the building principal approves in advance the presence of the telephone pager.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A student who is a member of a volunteer fire company, ambulance or rescue squad.</li> <li>2. A student who has a need for a telephone pager due to the medical condition of an immediate family member.</li> </ol> <p>Unauthorized possession of laser pointers, cellular telephones and telephone paging devices shall result in confiscation of the item by school personnel and appropriate discipline action.</p>	<p>SC 1317.1</p>
