313. NONTENURED EMPLOYEES	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>2. Authority</p>	<p>It is the policy of the Joint Operating Committee that certain administrators be employed with the recognition that they are not professional employees and will not attain tenure status.</p> <p>Effective school operation requires effective supervision by a variety of nontenured administrators. Such administrators are a key part of the school’s management force; however, their position does not require a professional certificate. Examples could include, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adult Education Supervisors • Food Service Supervisors • Maintenance Supervisors • Any position in which provision for tenure is not made by law. <p>No candidate shall be employed until such candidate has complied with the mandatory background check requirement and the school has evaluated the results of that screening process.</p>
