Authority	Strategic planning will be organized and conducted under the direction of the Joint Operating Committee by the Executive Planning Committee which shall consist of members representing the following groups: Business Leaders, Community Leaders, Teachers, Parents, Students, Support Staff, Administrators, Secondary District Representatives, Graduates, Adult Students.	
	Periodic reports shall be given to all appropriate decision makers: Joint Operating Committee, Professional Advisory Committee, Executive Planning Committee, Principals Committee, Guidance Committee, Occupations Committees, Faculty, Parents, Students.	
	The Executive Planning Committee is an on-going committee and will be included in the implementation and evaluation phase. The Committee will continue to assess, re-evaluate and recommend changes in the curriculum and the facilities. Feasibility studies will be performed as required.	
	The surveys employed in the needs assessment phase of strategic planning will be administered periodically to assess the needs of the students, to keep abreast of changes, and to recommend and update policy, facilities, and curriculum.
