	703. SANITARY MANAGEMENT	
1. Purpose	<p>The Joint Operating Committee recognizes that the health and physical well being of the students of this school depend in large measure upon the cleanliness and sanitary conditions of the school premises.</p>	
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that a program of sanitary management be instituted in the school and explained periodically to all staff members.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that standards be maintained that meet the requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor and Industry and any local agency which has jurisdiction.</p> <p>All the facilities of the school shall be regularly inspected for cleanliness and sanitation by the Maintenance Technician.</p>	<p>§701</p> <p>§3141</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Maintenance Technician shall develop and supervise a program for the cleanliness and sanitary management of the school buildings, school grounds and school equipment pursuant to statute, rules of the State Board, and regulations of the local and State Boards of Health and the Department of Labor and Industry.</p> <p>Cleanliness of the school shall be the responsibility of the Maintenance Technician.</p> <p>Teachers shall be responsible for the condition of their classrooms and shops.</p> <p>The administration shall inspect the facility at least once per month and identify any conditions which may threaten the comfort, health or safety of occupants.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">School Code</p>	<p>§701, 740, 3141</p>
