717. CAMERA SURVEILLANCE		
1. Purpose	<p>The employees of the Lebanon County Career and Technology Center (LCCTC) shall maintain order on school property to insure the safety of all students.</p> <p>All students, while on school property, shall conduct themselves in accordance with the rules of the LCCTC. The LCCTC expects that parents shall cooperate with school authorities in helping students maintain such conduct.</p>	
2. References	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall require each student to adhere to the rules of the LCCTC and to submit to such disciplinary measures as are appropriate. The rules of the LCCTC apply to each student during the time spent on school property and during the time spent in travel to and from school.</p> <p>The LCCTC may, from time to time, place and use video cameras, or other recording devices, on school property.</p> <p>The images recorded by the video camera or other recording devices may be used by school authorities to determine whether conduct occurred which is contrary to the rules of the LCCTC, to determine the extent of such conduct, and to determine the identity or identities of the particular student or students involved in such conduct.</p> <p>The images recorded by the video camera or other recording devices shall be admissible into evidence at any disciplinary proceeding conducted by the LCCTC.</p> <p>At the discretion of the school authorities, the images recorded by the video camera or other recording devices may be provided to any appropriate law enforcement agency.</p> <p>Public Notice. If the LCCTC utilizes video recording devices, notices should be posted at prominent locations to notify all students, parents, employees and members of the public that the LCCTC monitors conduct by recording devices such as video cameras. This notice is essential to insure that someone does not have a false expectation of privacy while on school property.</p> <p>Locker rooms and restrooms. The LCCTC should not place recording equipment in locker rooms or restrooms unless there is an extraordinary need for surveillance in those areas. If an extraordinary need arises, the placement of such equipment should occur only after careful legal review by the LCCTC's solicitor of the particular need for the use of such equipment, and the development of special controls concerning access to the recorded images.</p>	<p>School Code, 24 P.S. 5-10</p> <p>22 PA Code 12.3</p>
