Guidelines</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee welcomes the public at school events, but also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve the facilities of the school.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee has the authority to bar the attendance of any person at a school event whose conduct may constitute a disruption. The JOC also prohibits weapons, alcoholic beverages, gambling, and the use of controlled substances on school premises.</p> <p>The JOC prohibits tobacco use by any persons in the CTC building and on any property, buses, vans and vehicles owned, leased or controlled by the CTC.</p> <p>The CTC will annually notify staff, parents and members of the public about the CTC's tobacco use policy by publishing such in student and staff handbooks and on posted notices within the building.</p>	<p>SC 511, 775</p> <p>20 U.S. C., Sec. 7181 et seq. 35 P.S. 1223.5</p> <p>School Code</p> <p>511, 775</p>
