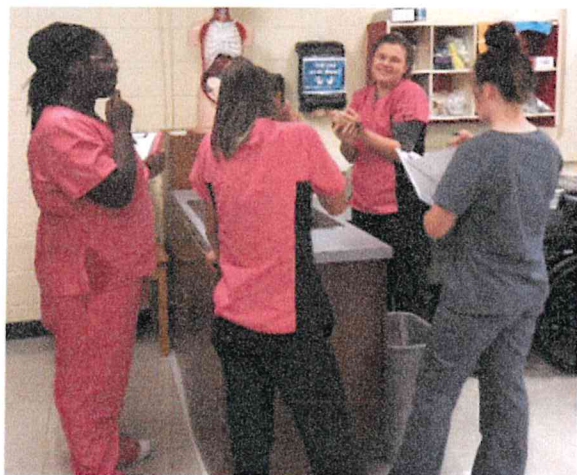

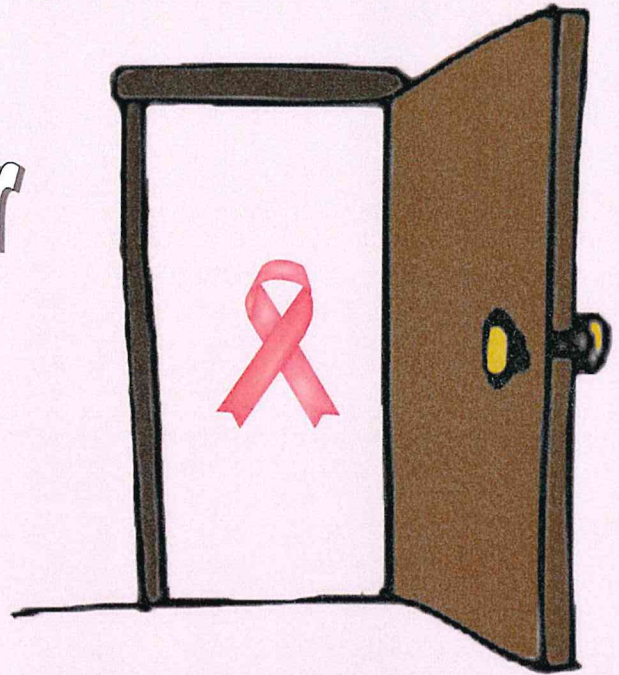

### Guest Speaker, Shane Manney, Shares Life Experiences!

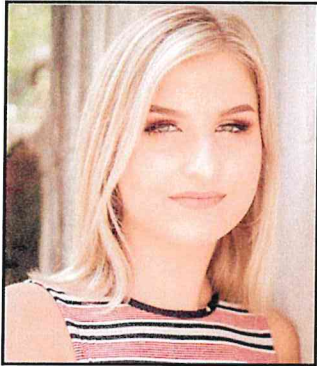

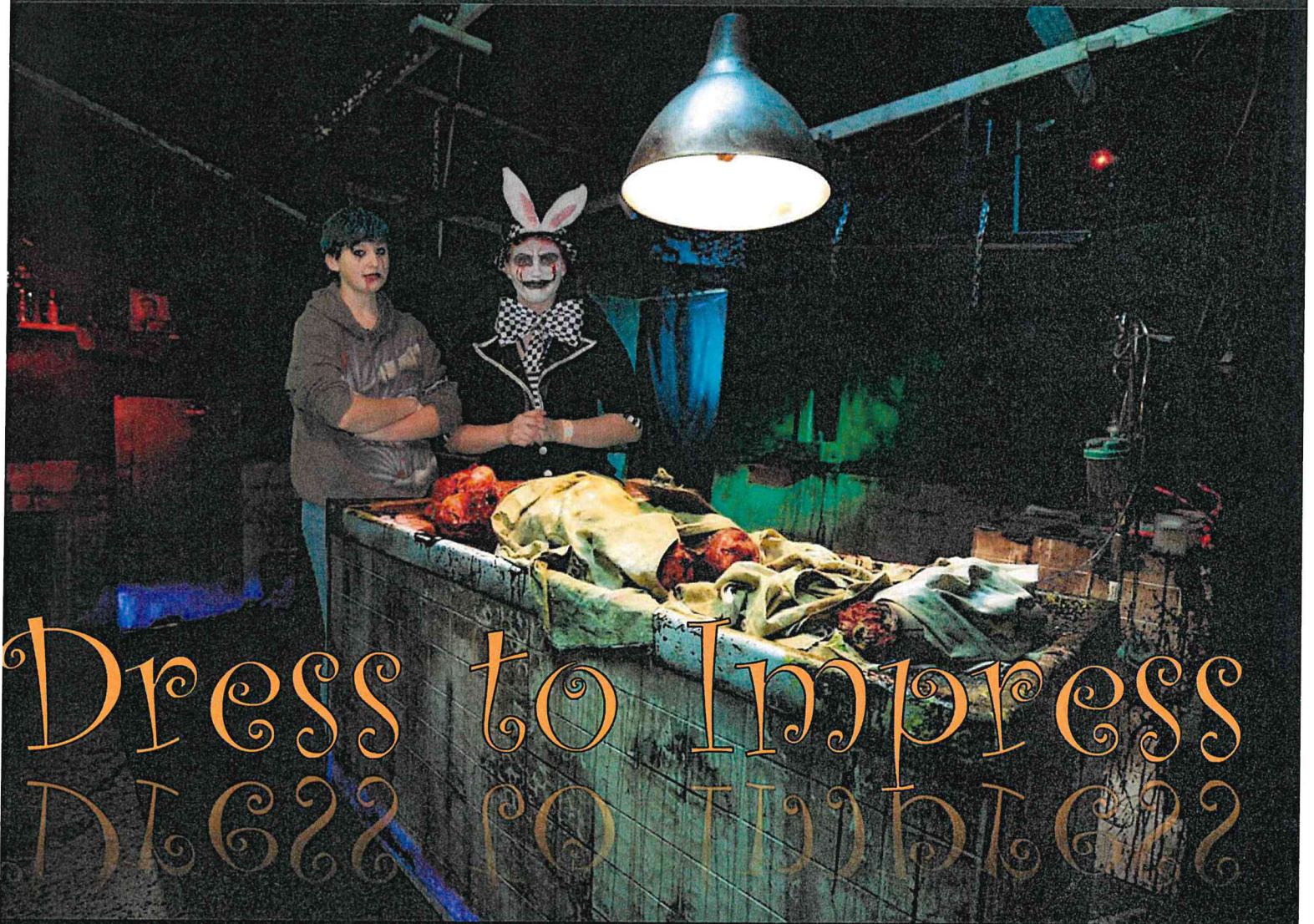
