



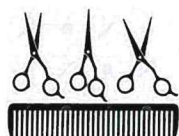

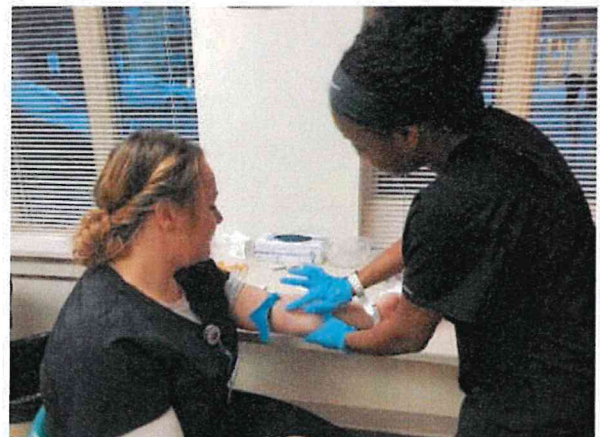
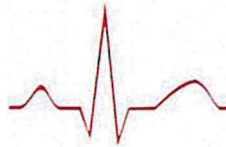
2018 Fall STI clinic at LFHS

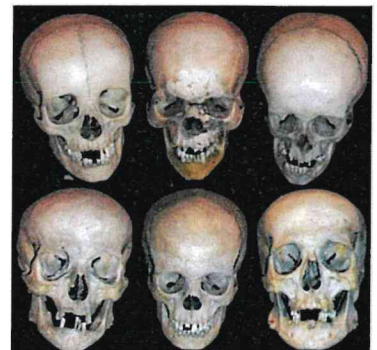


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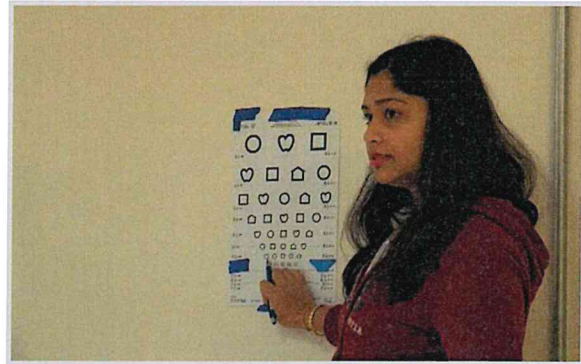
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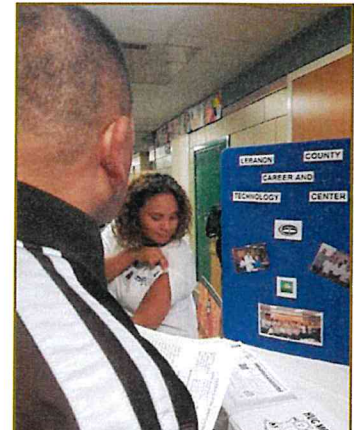
Practical Nursing Program—Community Service Projects

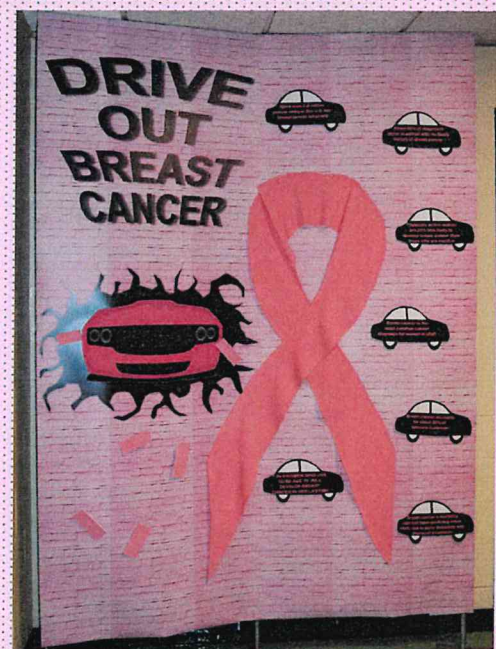

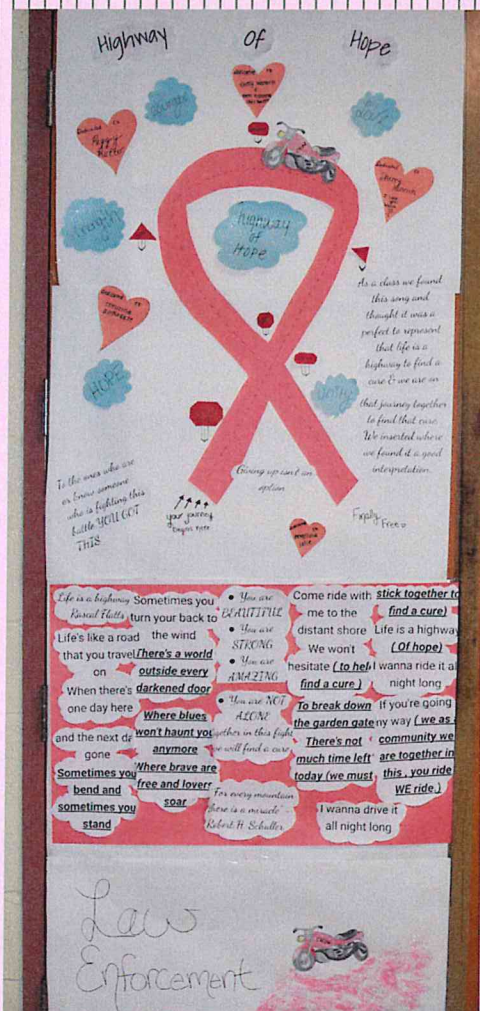

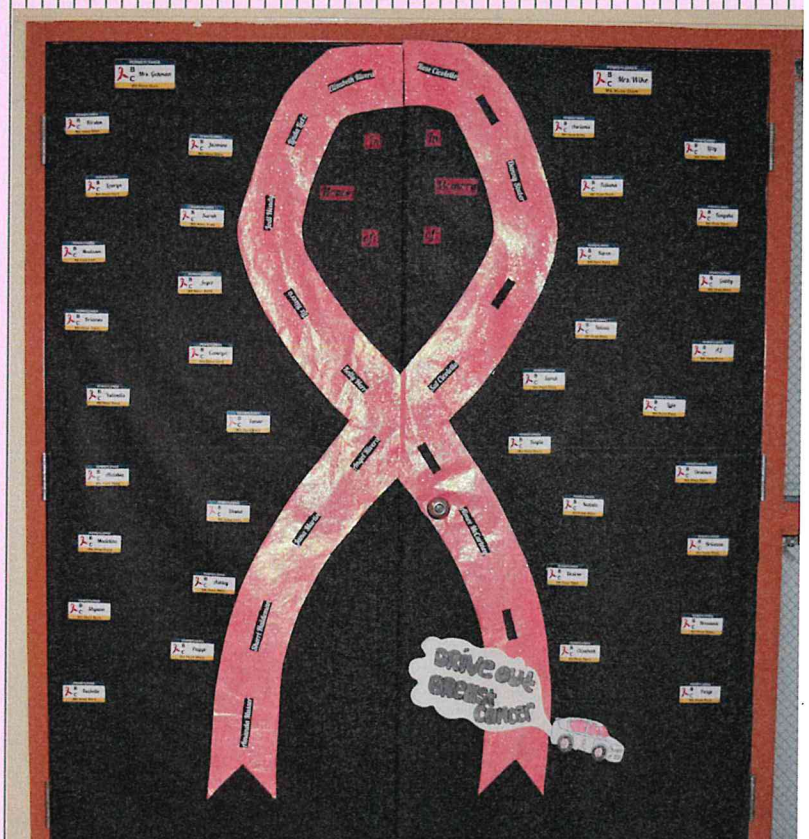

CTC staff and faculty would like to thank everyone who made our Community Open House such a success!

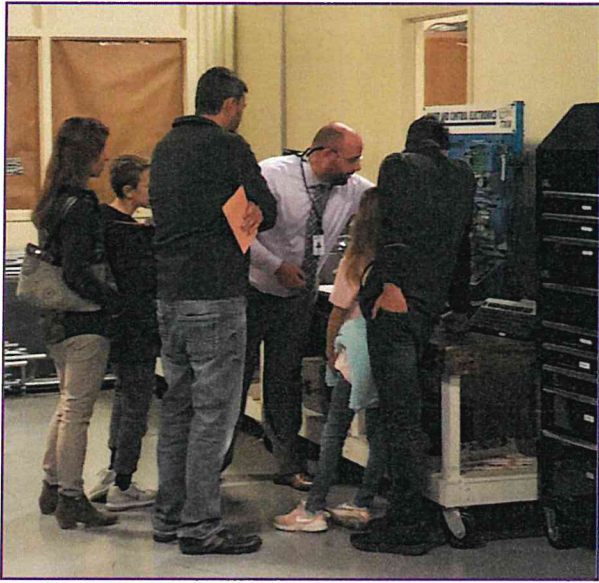


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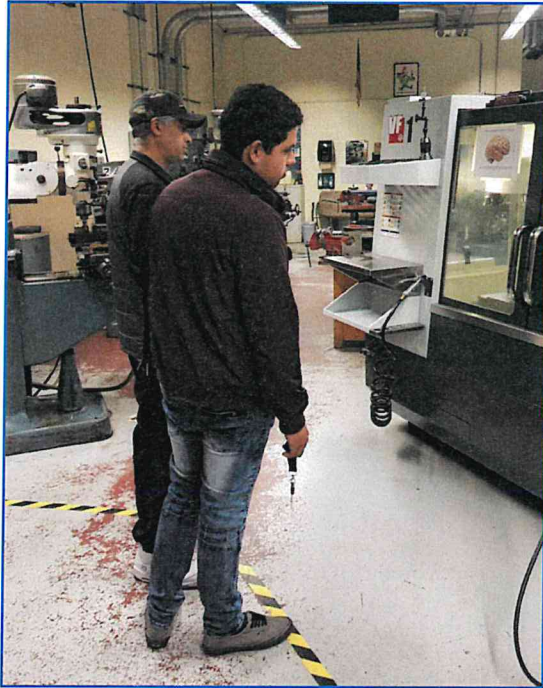
