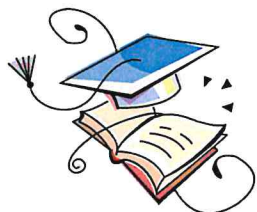

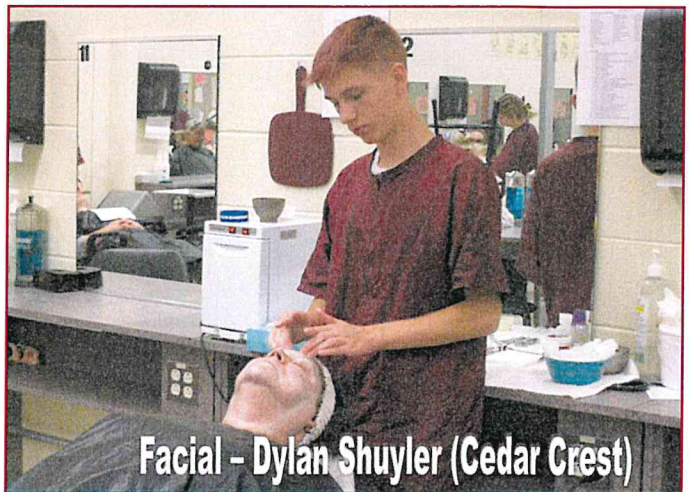

COSMETOLOGY

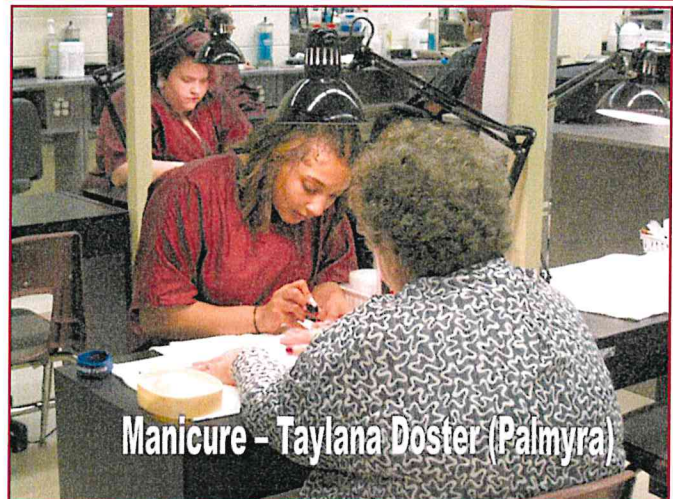

May 13, HCT HOSA traveled to NYC to the Ripley's Believe it or Not museum. Students viewed many human body abnormalities.

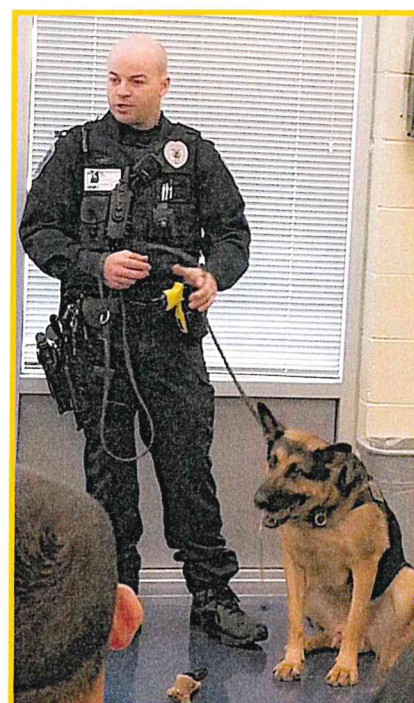


LAW ENFORCEMENT & SECURITY

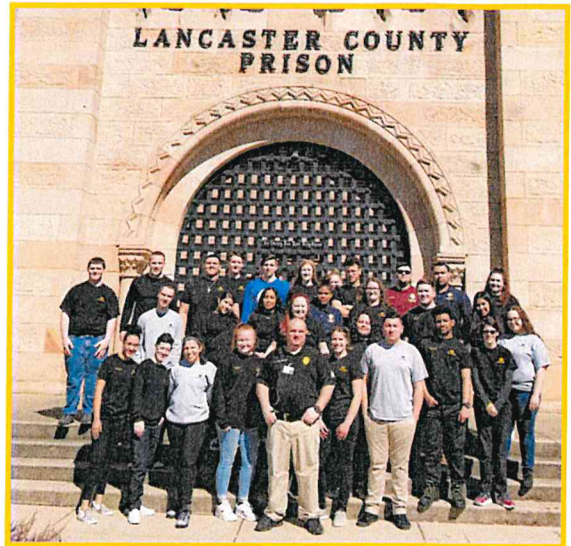

LAW ENFORCEMENT & SECURITY
