
National Nurses Week

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

This year brought on many new challenges for our students as they navigated through a changing world, but the school-to-work program still gave many students the opportunity to explore the workforce during the 2019-2020 school year. A total of 86 students participated in either clinical, cooperative education, internship or job shadowing opportunities. These experiences give students the opportunities to observe and/or work in the field of their program of study to gain more knowledge and understanding of the type of work that is done in that field.

The Medical Assistant students participated in clinical experiences in several healthcare facilities throughout Lebanon County while the Health Careers Technology students performed their clinical experiences at Cedar Haven Health Care. Additionally, there were 34 different cooperative education experiences; several of these students will continue employment with their cooperative education employers. The CTC thanks all the employers and businesses who give our students these very beneficial experiences!

Mind Tap is a cosmetology online training program that has PowerPoints, videos, demonstrations, and other various types of activities for students to work through. The program was offered free from Cengage during the Covid 19 pandemic. It will be available for the students for two years. It is a great tool to support cosmetology training. Students were assigned theory topics in the beginning and then the state board allowed review of procedures to be counted towards the 250 hours. After learning theory based subjects, students were able to review hands on procedures. Mind Tap kept track of the

hours students spent utilizing the different online learning activities. Seniors that left with almost 1000 hours in March were able to complete the cosmetology hour requirement. A few students have finished and completed the state board exam application and are waiting for a test date. As first year students return to class, the practical portion will be applied referring to the theory studied during this time. Class time will focus heavily on hands on procedures.

Two students also received awards for their outstanding abilities as cosmetology students. Emily Hartman received the outstanding clinic service award and Jenna Alt received the outstanding cosmetology student award. Both students have applied to take their state board exam and have jobs waiting for them. Emily will be working at His & Hers Cuts and Jenna will be working at Shear Elegance Salon.
