

Culinary and Pastry Arts Programs Receive "Exemplary" by the ACFEFAC

The Culinary and Pastry Arts programs recently received a five-year accreditation from the ACFEFAC (American Culinary Federation Education Foundation Accreditation Commission) and found zero non-compliances.

Both programs were identified as "Exemplary". To qualify as an ACFEF Exemplary Secondary Program, a program must be confirmed in full compliance with ACFEF standards on two consecutive Team Reports.

The team evaluating the program participated in an onsite visit and determined through a checklist and comparison of the program to the nationally recognized ACFEF Standards that the program has substantially met the entire required standards. They are as follows:

Reminder for our Visitors . . .

School Gate Guardian

School Gate Guardian requires all visitors to present a valid driver's license or other state-issued identification upon arrival at the door. The ID will be scanned and checked. Visitors who have been cleared will receive a printed ID badge that includes their photo and name. The badge is self-expiring, meaning within 12 hours of receipt, the word "VOID" will bleed through to the front so the badge cannot be reused. The process to scan an ID, run the check and print a badge takes about 30 seconds to complete.
