## LCCTC Delivers First-Ever Virtual SkillsUSA PA District Competition

The Lebanon County Career and Technology Center has hosted many SkillsUSA PA district competitions in the past. That usually means 300+ students, advisors, and judges visit the school to participate in many skills and leadership contests.

This year's competition, however, was like no other. LCCTC imagined, created, and delivered 27 contests in which participants competed via live-streaming Zoom meetings. Most of the students competed from their own vocational-technical schools, and several even participated from their homes. Students from Adams County Technical Institute, Dauphin County Technical School, Milton Hershey School, and LCCTC took advantage of this unique opportunity to compete.

Traditional, tried-and-true contests such as Commercial Baking, Culinary Arts, and Masonry were offered. Students could also participate in new-to-Lebanon contests like T-Shirt Design, CNC Milling/Turning, and Medical Terminology. Awards were announced in the form of a PowerPoint slide show, and medals and certificates were sent out in the mail to the participating schools.

Shawn Eckenrode, school director at Adams County Technical Institute, said, "Whoever thought that we could/ would have had a virtual SkillsUSA competition?? Thank you to everyone involved in providing this unusual but successful opportunity to our students...they enjoyed it!"
