

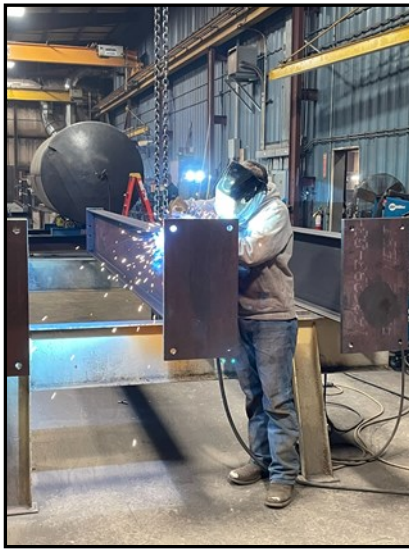

We were able to capture some pictures of a few of our students at their jobs during the month of March. If any student is interested in learning more about our co-op program, contact Mrs. Flowers.



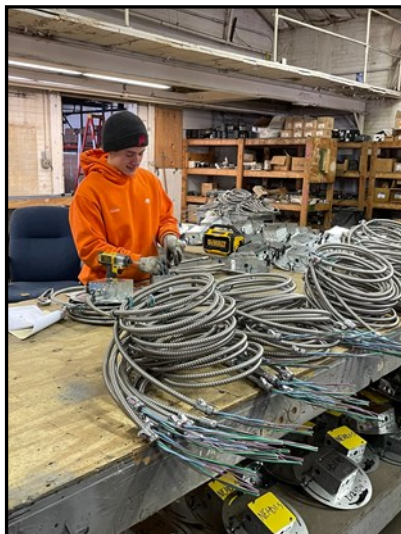
