## Lebanon County Career and Technology Center Plumbing, and HVAC

Welcome to the Plumbing and HVAC class here at the Lebanon County Career and Technology Center

I am looking forward to teaching your student the fundamentals of the plumbing and heating trade. I am looking at structuring my class as plumbing the first 2 marking periods and transitioning to HVAC and oil burners the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> marking period of your students first year. The second year I am looking at the students to start the first marking period in HVAC where we left off and then transitioning to plumbing the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> marking period to prep for our NOCTI Knowledge and practical testing. The 4<sup>th</sup> marking period I will talk to the students on what area they want to learn more about. Some students like the plumbing side and others like HVAC, so at this time they would get projects that they chose to learn about. Our first year we enroll in an OSHA construction course that is a 10-hour course that we work on throughout the first half of the year, and complete it by the start of the 3<sup>rd</sup> marking period. Some of this could be homework assignments to complete.

In class we use our school computers a lot. I usually start the day off having daily questions on Schoology. School computers should be charged and ready to be used. Cell phones Will not be used for answering these questions. Cell phones are a distraction in class and should only be used at specific times allowed and they are required to put their phones in the lockers at the front of the class.

In the shop we use a lot of power and hand tools and torches, so if you have long hair, it should be pulled back to not interfere while working either with a hair band or a hat.

Dress Code: Our plumbing and HVAC shop has a uniform which must be worn while at LCCTC. Our shop uniform is a navy-blue tee shirt, short sleeve, or long sleeve. Blue jeans with no holes in them, and steel toe work boots. Students need to arrive to class by the bell with full uniform and safety gear on.

Uniforms must be purchased through Major League, to purchase these, go to the following.

and click on uniforms it's in the upper right-hand corner, then click program choice
(Plumbing) and you can order uniforms. The navy-blue tee shirts and sweatshirts are fine with blue
jeans or dickies work pants that you can purchase wherever you would like.

Sweatpants/Joggers/long shorts/capris/leggings/etc. ARE NOT acceptable clothing to work in the shop. Any orders made to Major League will be delivered to the school and handed out on the first completed day of school. Work boots are a requirement to work in the shop. Safety is an important thing in our shop, sneakers and sandals cannot be worn.
